Subject: Removal of Aromatic Petroleum Hydrocarbons and
Petroleum Distillates from the Active Ingredient
Section of the Label
EPA Registration No. 11715-83

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with
registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide
Act, is acceptable subject to the following comments:

1. Replace the Statement of Practical Treatment with the following:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a
physician or Poison Control
Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing
and wash affected areas with
soap and water. Get medical
attention if irritation
persists.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of
water. Get medical attention
if irritation persists.

Note To Physicians: Contains petroleum
distillate. Vomiting may
cause aspiration
pneumonia.

2. Revise the Active Ingredients section to read:


Resmethrin 0.284%
