Hold bottle uprighand point nozzle opening in desired direction of spray. Pump the cap up and down with forefinger to create spray. Apply at the rate of two seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs, up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long-haired dogs. Spray the animal from a distance of 3-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face or genitals. Repeat weekly, if needed. Do Not Use On Dogs Under 12 Weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.
