The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the final printed labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. Correct the ingredient statement appearing on the product label to delete the figure "38.35%" for total active ingredients. The total for the inert ingredients should read "61.65%", and not "61.95%".
- Delete the reference to "extra" spray which appears on the product label in the section titled "FOR CIOTHING". This label language is inconsistent with the DEET LIP.
