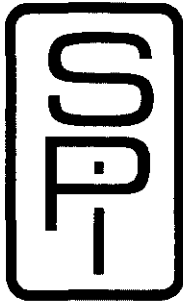

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read all directions before using this product. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin.

Hold unit 8-12 inches from skin or clothing while spraying, keeping nozzle pointed away from face. Slightly moisten skin or clothing with a slow sweeping motion. Apply on face by first spraying small amounts in palm of hand and spreading on face or neck. Do not apply to eyes or mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness.
