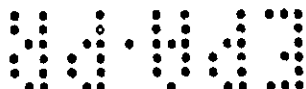
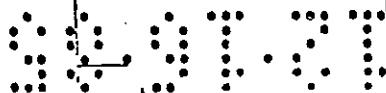

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes and lips. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes and lips with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Physical Hazards

Extremely Flammable, contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, heated surfaces, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Contains ethyl alcohol. Do not light matches or expose skin or clothing to fire until alcohol has evaporated (approximately 10 minutes). May damage some plastics, varnished or painted surfaces. Do not use on Rayon, Spandex or Dynel. May be used on Nylon, Orlon, wool or cotton.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Remove protective cap, and spray from a distance of 8-12 inches from surface to be protected. Slightly moisten surface—saturation is not necessary. Use slow sweeping motion.

FOR EXPOSED SKIN AREAS, to repel flies, gnats and mosquitoes: Use as directed above. **AVOID CONTACT WITH EYES OR MOUTH.** For treating face, spray in palm of hand, rub palms together and rub on face.

FOR CLOTHING, to repel ticks, fleas and chiggers: (See CAUTION)—Make liberal application along all openings of the clothing, such as inside the neck band, the fly and cuffs of trousers, tops of socks, eyelets of shoes and areas of clothing which may contact the ground, weeds or other growth.
