

Precautionary Statements Hazards to Humans

CAUTION

For external use only. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, lips or open cuts. Do not expose treated skin or clothing to fire, sparks or flame until liquid has evaporated. Do not allow children to rub eyes if hands have been treated.

Physical Hazards

Extremely Flammable. Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, heated surfaces, sparks or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 degrees F may cause bursting. Contains alcohol. Do not light matches or expose skin or clothing to fire until alcohol has evaporated (approximately 10 minutes). May damage some plastics, varnished or painted surfaces. Do not use on Rayon, Spandex or Dynel. May be used on Nylon, Orlon, wool or cotton.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - Do not induce vomiting. Consult a physician.
If on skin - May cause skin reactions in rare cases. If so, wash thoroughly with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If in eyes - Wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.
Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap, and spray from a distance of 8 - 12 inches from surface to be protected. Slightly moisten surface -saturation is not necessary. Use a slow sweeping motion.

FOR EXPOSED SKIN AREAS, to repel flies, gnats and mosquitoes: Use as directed above. **AVOID CONTACT WITH EYES OR MOUTH.** For treating face, spray in palm of hand, rub palms together and rub on face.

FOR CLOTHING, to repel ticks, fleas and chiggers: (See CAUTION) -Make liberal application along all openings of the clothing, such as the neck band, the fly and cuffs of trousers, tops of socks, eyelets of shoes and areas of clothing which may contact the ground, weeds or other growth.
