STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Make liberal application along all openings of the clothing, such as the neck band, the fly and the cuffs or trousers, tops of socks, eyelets of shoes and areas of clothing which may contact the ground, weeds or other growth.
