Spiders: Apply spray around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Surfaces behind and beneath cabinets: Roaches, ants, silverfish—as a supplement to good housekeeping, spray surfaces behind and beneath cabinets where insects tend to hide. Spray until wet. Remove all food before spraying. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

Outdoors

Chiggers, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Clover Mites: For treatment of localized infestation of insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation to be used for food or feed, spray infested areas. For ants, wet hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

Porches, Patios, Garages, and other areas around the house where insects hide and congregate: To help keep flies, mosquitoes, wasps, and flying moths from entering the house, treat outdoor areas where these insects congregate. This treatment can be an effective addition to total pest control.
