

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, modify the statement, "All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using", by substituting the following precaution:

"All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse. Remove pets and cover fish aquariums before spraying."

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION
