Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Webbing Clothes Moths, and other insects in cracks and windows and direct spray in room with a slow sweeping motion every 30 seconds for average room. Keep room closed 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate before re-entry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, and many insects as possible direct spray to thorough spraying of suspected of harboring these pests. Should be paid to cracks, hidden behind stoves and refrigerators, wherever these pests are suspected. To kill ants, treat doors, window areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Direct spray as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of furniture. Both top and bottom surfaces should be sprayed thoroughly. Closets, areas under furniture should be sprayed. Repeat if insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confusion: Toothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Weevils: Find and destroy insects. Remove all other items from paper to kill any of the named insects. Paper on the shelves and return to have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Wasps: Contact insecticide. Sweep up and discard fallen wasps. Repeat as necessary.
