The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

Under Storage and Disposal, add the following statement: 1.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for quidance.

- Change the statement "Contains aromatic petroleum 2. distillates" to "Contains xylene range aromatic solvents".
- 3. Under the Directions for Use, add the statements:

Do not spray within 30 days of slaughter. Do not treat overheated or sick animals. Do not use on poultry.

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goats and horses. Thus, on the front panel add:

A Screwworm and Ear Tick Killer for Use on Beef Cattle, Sheep, Goats and Horses.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

We acknowledge and accept the removal of methylene chloride from the formulation, however in accordance with 40 CFR 180.1001(e), 1,1,1,-Trichlorothane must not be present in more than 25% of the pesticide formulation, therefore the formulation is not acceptable. Note that the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated August 18, 1988, (alternate formulation) and the CSF dated November 1, 1985 (basic formulation) are <u>same</u> formulation. Please clarify.

Hold nozzle 4 inches away from wound during application, ar. continue to spray until it is completely covered and wet. Work thoroughly into wounds and open holes. Spray a light application on drainage area below wounds. Color has been added to this product to enable easy identification of treated wounds. Repeat application twice weekly until wound is healed.

Some strains of screwworms may develop resistance to lindane. This will be observed by lack of response to treatment. Protect Uninfested Wounds: Spray all wounds on cattle, sheep, goats and horses, such as wire cuts, shear cuts, docking and dehorning, as soon as possible to avoid infestation. Repeat at 7 days intervals until healed. Young Calves: Young calves over 3 months old spray sparingly. Never use more than necessary for adequate coverage of affected area.

To Kill Fleece Worm: Spray directly on infested area and orainage area below. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Spinose Ear Tick: In cattle, horses, goats and sheep. Gracp animal's ear firmly and direct spray downward into the ear. Release spray for three seconds per ear in treating cattle and two seconds per ear in treating smaller animals. Do not use on calves under the age of 3 months.
