Submission dated October 16, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1) In accordance with the Allethrin Registration Standard, delete the phrase "allyl homolog of Cinerin 1" from the active ingredient declaration for d trans allethrin.
- 2) Delete the term "related compounds" from the label ingredients declaration. Unless otherwise substantiated, these isomers should be considered inert. If the "related compounds" are determined to be active, they should be incorporated in the declaration for the active ingredient and not distinguished as "related compounds" or "other isomers".
- 3) Correct the active ingredient declaration for sumithrin to read exactly as follows: "3-phenoxybenzyl-(1RS, 3RS; 1RS, 3SR)-2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl)cyclopropanecarboxylate". Refer to the Sumithrin Registration Standard for further guidance.
