 Submission dated May 18, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. In the section titled **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS, HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**, revise the third paragraph to read as follows:

Cover or remove all exposed food. In the home, all food contact surfaces and utensils should be covered or removed prior to treatment or thoroughly washed before use. In food processing facilities, do not apply when food processing is underway. In food processing plants, all benches, shelving, food processing surfaces, and utensils should be covered or removed prior to treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

2. Revise the **Pesticide Disposal** section of the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** portion of the product label to read as follows:

**Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

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3. Revise statement (b) which appears in the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** section of the product label to read as follows:

(b) All containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal at an approved waste disposal facility, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

6. For the record, submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula.

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# **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

When used in hospitals, patients should be moved prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Do not apply when food processing is underway.

**If on skin or clothing:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

## **DIRECTIONS**

It is a violation of the law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with these directions.

## **STORAGE**

**Storage:** Store in original container, tightly closed.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Do not reuse or chemically alter. Dispose of at a landfill approved for hazardous waste, away from water and food or feed by strict prohibition.

**Container disposal:**

(a) Containers of 5 gallons or less may be offered for recycling, reconditioning, or reuse.

(b) All containers - 5 gallons or more - must be recycled, reconditioned, or buried in a safe place.

**General:** Consult local authorities for appropriate disposal.

**IN MISTING EQUIPMENT:** Use similar to a Micro Mist Sprayer.

**TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS:**

Close room, warehouse, or garage. Shut off all ventilating fans.

Apply a fine mist. Use a dose of 1 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet.

Remain in treated area for 2 hours. Ventilate the area after application as needed.

**IN PRESSURIZED MISTING INSECT SPRAYERS:**

To kill the listed insects, use at a rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 cubic feet.

**TO KILL COCKROACHES:**

Contact as many insects as possible in addition to thorough spraying.

Pay special attention to areas suspected of harboring cockroaches.

Should be paid to cockroaches behind stoves and under sinks.
