

Regarding product 11715-100, revise the statement which begins "After space spraying...", which appears in the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section of the product label, to read as follows: After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
- 2. Regarding product 11715-113, delete the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" from the product label, as this product does not contain a significant amount of petroleum distillates to warrant this statement.
