The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the respective final printed labels prior to releasing the products for shipment. Stamped copies of the respective product labels are enclosed for your records.

1. Regarding product 11715-100, revise the statement which begins "After space spraying...", which appears in the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section of the product label, to read as follows: After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
2. Regarding product 11715-113, delete the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" from the product label, as this product does not contain a significant amount of petroleum distillates to warrant this statement.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F. may cause bursting.
