Precautionary Statements

CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid contamination of food and food-stuffs. Wash hands with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children to lie, play or sleep in treated areas until at least six hours following treatment.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, or serving areas or in household storage areas. In home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

For barns - Remove animals before applying. Do not treat animals. Do not contaminate milk or milking utensils. Ventilate before allowing animals to reoccupy treated buildings.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. If used directly over asphalt or no wax tile, place in a large pan.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a Physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Irritated: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

Use one canister for each 5,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Example: 25' long x 20' wide x 10' high = 5,000 cu. ft. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of the mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper, or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks - this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave building at once.

DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR TWO HOURS, then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for one hour before reoccupying area. If additional units are used for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured, increase airing out time accordingly.
