The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Revise the "If Swallowed" portion of the Statement of Practical Treatment by adding "...due to aspiration hazard." to the sentence, "Do not induce vomiting".

2. The submitted label ingredient percentages do not total 100%. Unless otherwise indicated, the percentage of other isomers for allethrin as listed on the previously accepted label should be added to the percentage of active ingredient to correct the discrepancy.

3. Retain the ingredient statement footnotes concerning isomers as listed on the previously approved label.
