DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN NON FOOD AREAS

**Spot Application (Do not fog):** Spray only with wet spray, not paint surfaces.

**Granary Weevils and Rice Weevils (exposed stages), Roaches, Waterbugs and Silverfish:** liberally into all cracks, underneath skins, tables, chairs, around windows, doors, machinery and motor bases, and around pipe spray walls where insects are congregating. tops and bottoms of baseboards, or where floors meet.

**Ants:** Treat as roaches, paying particular attention to surfaces where ants travel, ant trails, and where they enter a room or building—such as the inside surfaces of window frames, door frames and corners. Pour residual insecticide over and into ant hills several times if necessary.

**Flies (outdoors only):** Spray or paint on screen outside walls around doors. Spray all places where flies congregate. Wet surfaces well, but to extent that insecticide runs off. Surfaces subject to frequent cleaning, or weathering may require application.

**Carpet Beetles:** Spray heavily wherever they are seen or suspected, such as behind baseboards along edges of carpets, under rugs or floor corners in or between floor and baseboard. Repeat every few days. In all cases of insect infestation above procedures several times.
