

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, delete petroleum distillate as an active ingredient and add its percentage to the total for inerts. You may add a substatement to the ingredients statement "Contains petroleum distillate". Also, delete "General Classification". The uses of this pesticide have not been classified.

The formula statement dated August 10, 1988 is acceptable and has been added to the files for this pesticide. It is understood that the use of methylene chloride in the formulation is no longer consistent with the terms of its registration.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Inhaled** — Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If On Skin or Clothing** — Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
- If In Eyes** — Flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.
- If Swallowed** — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting without medical supervision because of possible aspiration hazard.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

Do not apply directly to food. In food plants do not use while food processing is underway. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Remove all motor vehicles before using in garages.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
- Disposal:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

To kill ticks, destroy old pet bedding and replace. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product prior to reentry.

For Use Only When Building Has Been Vacated By Humans, Beasts And Pets.

Use one canister for each 5,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Example: 25' long x 20' high = 5,000 cu. ft. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the free flow of the mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper, or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows. Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Remove and dispose of infested food and feed products prior to fogging.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks — this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc., and leave building at once. **DO NOT REENTER BUILDING FOR TWO HOURS** Then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

REPEAT AS NECESSARY.
