FIRST AID

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To kill ticks, destroy old bedding and replace. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product prior to reentry.

FOR USE ONLY WHEN BUILDING HAS BEEN VACATED BY HUMAN BEINGS AND PETS.

Use one canister for each 5,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area.

Example: 25' long x 20' wide x 10' high = 5,000 cu.ft. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the free flow of the mist is not assured.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. x 5 ft. or smaller, instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms.

Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

PREPARATION: Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks- this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave building at once. **Do not reenter building for two hours.** Then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area. **Repeat as necessary.**

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
