HAZARDS

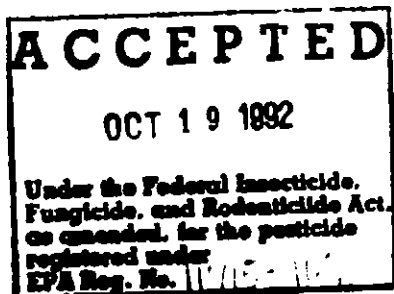

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL  
TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, apply artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash immediately with plenty of soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with Atropine. This product does contain petroleum distillates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover or remove exposed foods. Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces. Keep children and pets out of treatment area and cover fish bowls and aquariums during treatment. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas until spray has dried. Do not use as a space spray - FOR SURFACE APPLICATION ONLY.

IMPORTANT - HOLD CONTAINER IN UPRIGHT POSITION TO SPRAY. SHAKE WELL. Direct spray away from face. Hold container 6 to 12 inches from surface and spray at a rate of 1 foot per second or until surfaces are wet. If reinfestations occur, repeat applications as necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, AND CEN-  
TIPEDES: Thoroughly spray cracks, crevices, baseboards and around garbage containers and other places where insects habitate.

ANTS: Spray ant trails, window frames, door sills and other places where ants may enter. Spray directly on ant hills or on swarming ants outdoors only.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS: Apply to screens, walls, doors and window frames, light fixtures and other outdoor surfaces where insects congregate.

CLOVER MITES, SOWBUGS, AND EARWIGS: Spray window and door sills and other points of entry- outside only. Apply also to outside foundation and porches to ground level.

SILVERFISH AND FIREBRATS: Apply to cracks, baseboards, behind shelving, bookcases and other storage areas.

PAPER NEST WASPS AND MUD DAUBERS: Apply a wet spray to the nests after dark when all pests have returned to their nests.

SCORPIONS AND SPIDERS: Spray directly on pests when possible. Treat surfaces of out buildings and garages where pests hide or congregate. Spray points of entry such as windowsills and along crevices.

BROWN DOG TICK: Remove all bedding. Thoroughly spray cracks, crevices and areas where pets normally lie down. Do not spray on pets. Allow the sprayed areas to dry thoroughly. Replace bedding before permitting use by animals. For dog kennels, apply to outside runway, windowsills and ledges. Use a product registered by EPA for direct application to pets.
