Hazards to Humans and Domestic
Animals
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL
TREATMENT**

If swallowed - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

If in eyes - Rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

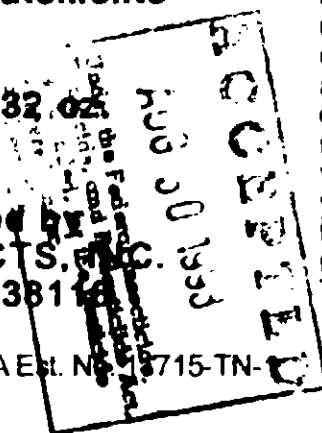

To Kill Cockroaches, Spiders and Sowbugs: Pests are found or may be found in rooms and closets, baseboards and door frames, beneath sinks, stove, around garbage can, etc. Pests driven away by spraying directly. Repeat around doors and windows. Pests may find entrance.
