Subject: Revised Labeling
Speer Dairy & Food Plant Insecticide
EPA Registration Number 11715-111
Submission dated May 15, 1992

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Delete the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" from the front panel of the product label. This statement is appropriate for products which contain significant amounts of petroleum distillates.

2. Revise the pesticide disposal statement to read as follows:

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes (pesticide or rinsate) resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

3. In the section titled "HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS", delete the statement "If swallowed do not induce vomiting".

4. Revise the statement "When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment", which appears in the **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS** section, to read as follows: **In hospitals, remove patients prior to treatment.**

5. In the section titled **HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**, revise the statement which begins "After spraying in meat packing plants,..." to read as follows: After spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and food processing plants, wash all benches, shelving, food processing utensils, and food handling surfaces with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

6. Revise the **If swallowed** section of the label to read as follows:

If swallowed: Drink two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

7. Add the following statement to the front panel of the product label:

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN USDA INSPECTED MEAT AND POULTRY PROCESSING PLANTS.

8. Submit a current CSF providing all of the necessary information including the pH of the product and the certified limits.
