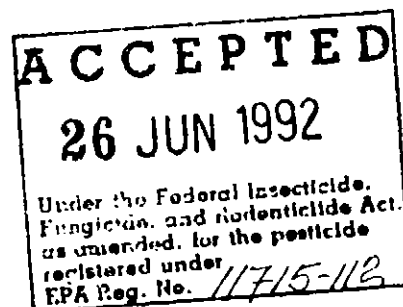
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control
Center

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical
attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and warm water. Get
medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and call a
physician if effects occur.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a
manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL

Hold can upright about 10 to 12 inches from pet. Start
spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and
making sure that the animal's entire body is covered,
including legs and underside. Fluff the hair so that the
spray will penetrate to the skin. Wet ticks thoroughly.
Do not spray into eyes, face or scrotum. Towel dry,
comb and brush coat. Repeat once a week if neces-
sary. Use on bedding and surrounding area as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open
flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard containers in trash.
Do not incinerate or puncture.
