The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the respective final printed labels prior to releasing the products for shipment. Stamped copies of the respective product labels are enclosed for your records.

1. Regarding product 11715-100, revise the statement which begins "After space spraying...", which appears in the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS** section of the product label, to read as follows: After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
2. Regarding product 11715-113, delete the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" from the product label, as this product does not contain a significant amount of petroleum distillates to warrant this statement.

3. For both of the products referenced above, submit current Confidential Statements of Formula for the respective records. Ensure that the bulk density, flash back, flame extension, and all other pertinent information is provided on the CSFs.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin; wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not treat or cause exposure of kittens less than four weeks old. Cover or remove aquariums before use.
