SPEER HOSPITAL SPRAY DISINFECTANT/DEODORANT kills influenza, T.B. Bacillus, deadly Staphylococci, Salmonella, Trichophyton (the athlete's foot fungus) on cleaned hard inanimate non-porous surfaces.

Spray regularly to eliminate odors from bedsteads, bed spring, bedside tables, bathroom, seats, shower stalls, bathtubs, door handles, light switches, window blinds, empty waste receptacles, sills, walls, places where germs may be an aerosol spray penetrates and reach with non-propelled liquids.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is violation of Federal law to use in a manner inconsistent with its label.

TO DISINFECT: Thoroughly clean surface to be disinfected prior to application. Spray upright, 6" to 8" from surface 2 to 3 seconds until fine mist. Let dry on surface.

TO DEODORIZE: Hold can upright and spray into center of room 1 to 2 minutes. **MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROLS:** basements, closets, laundry, mer cottages, boats, storage stalls. Inhibits the growth of dew on mattresses, pillows, curtains, painted surfaces, tiled and similar surfaces. For mold and mildew control, follow directions for disinfection. Disinfection should be repeated on surfaces when new growth appears. Surfaces should be cleaned before application.
