### HOSPITAL SPRAY DISINFECTANT/DEODORANT

**KILLS ODORS.** Spray into the air to eliminate cooking, bathroom and smoke odors.

#### WARNING

Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with food or food utensils.

#### PHYSICAL HAZARDS

**SPEER HOSPITAL SPRAY DISINFECTANT-DEODORANT** kills Influenza A2 virus, deadly Staphylococci, Streptococci, Salmonella, Trichophyton interdigitale (the athlete's foot fungus) on pre-cleaned hard inanimate nonporous environmental surfaces.

Spray regularly to eliminate most germs from bedsteads, bed springs, bed rails, bedside tables, bathroom basins, toilet seats, shower stalls, bathtubs, telephones, door handles, light switches, plumbing fixtures, window blinds, empty hampers, waste receptacles, sills, walls, closets, and other inanimate hard surfaces. The aerosol spray penetrates areas hard to reach with non-propelled liquid disinfectants.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**TO DISINFECT:** Thoroughly clean surfaces to be disinfected prior to application. Hold can upright, 6" to 8" from surface. Spray surface 2 to 3 seconds until covered with fine mist. Let dry on surface.

**TO DEODORIZE:** Hold can upright and spray into center of room 1 to 2 seconds.

**MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL:** Use in basements, closets, laundry rooms, summer cottages, boats, storage areas, shower stalls. Inhibits the growth of mold and mildew on mattresses, pillows, shower curtains, painted surfaces, tiled walls, curtains, leather goods (such as purses, coats, shoes and boots) and similar "precleaned outer inanimate" surfaces. For mildew control, follow directions for disinfection. Application should be repeated once a week or when new growth appears on hard surfaces. Surfaces should be cleaned prior to application.
