The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment by adding:

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and call a physician if effects occur.

Also, revise under IF SWALLOWED as follows:

Get medical attention immediately.

2. Change "Physical Hazards" to "Physical or Chemical Hazards."
3. Add "Extremely Flammable" to the Physical or Chemical Hazards section.
4. Change "Destroy old pet bedding..." to "Destroy pet's old bedding..."
5. Add a street address or P.O. Box number to the address on the front panel.

The new chemistry data matrix submitted is acceptable and has been made a part of the record for this product.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

#### Precautionary Statements

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames except pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks. This will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc., and leave building at once. DO NOT ENTER BUILDING FOR ONE HOUR then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy old pet bedding and replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.
