The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide registration Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

- For all products add the statement "Shut off electrical 1. equipment."
- For EPA Reg. Numbers 11715-137 and 11715-178, make the 2. following changes:
  - Delete the term "unobstructed areas" а. sentence "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of the mist is not assured."
  - Add the statements "Place cant at least 6 feet from pilot lights." and "Use only one can per room."
- For EPA Reg. Number 11718-137, add the statement "Do not 3. place in cabinet or under counter or table."
- EPA Reg. Number 11715-178, delete the "Exclusive" from the statement "Exclusive Water-based Formula" since words or phrases implying that a product. possesses unique characteristics because composition are not acceptable.
