Your Application Dated August 15, 1995

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. For all products add the statement "Shut off electrical equipment."
2. For EPA Reg. Numbers 11715-137 and 11715-178, make the following changes:
 - a. Delete the term "unobstructed areas" and the sentence "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of the mist is not assured."
 - b. Add the statements "Place cant at least 6 feet from pilot lights." and "Use only one can per room."
3. For EPA Reg. Number 11718-137, add the statement "Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table."
4. For EPA Reg. Number 11715-178, delete the word "Exclusive" from the statement "Exclusive Water-based Formula" since words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Wash hands with soap and water after using and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children to be or sleep in treated areas until at least six hours following treatment. Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, or serving areas or in household storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **If on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **If in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention, if irritation persists. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

This water-base formula has no strong solvent odor - is not staining - and won't damage carpets, rugs, drapes or floors.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the directions on the label.

Use one canister for each 500 cu. ft. of area. Example: 25' long x 20' wide x 8' high = 4,000 cu. ft. Use additional units as needed. Free flow of the mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Cover food handling equipment, copper articles (lamps, art objects), cabinets and doors to areas of air conditioning. Put pilot light. Remove pets, bowls with paper, or remove doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING: Place canister in center of area. Place several thick towels around canister to prevent marring. Push down on top of canister and eyes. Push down on top of canister will start fogging action. Position on table, etc. and

DO NOT RE-ENTER BATHROOMS, HOURS, then open exterior doors to allow to air for one hour. If additional units are used, free flow of mist is not assured accordingly.

STORAGE

Do not contaminate water. Dispose of container. **Storage:** Store in cool, dry place. **Disposal:** Dispose of container in trash. Do not reuse.
