Dear Mrs. Butler:

The revised labeling and formulation referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's condition as enumerated in this letter below and submit three copies of your final, printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. The statement "Treat all cracks and crevices, such as baseboards and around the bottoms of doors." is confusing and must be revised. It should be revised as follows: "Spray cracks and crevices along and behind baseboards and door frames."

This letter acknowledges change of the official name of record of this product to "SPI SPOT TREATMENT SPRAY (with chlorpyrifos)". Our files have been updated to reflect this change. Any future correspondence regarding this registration should refer to this name.

We also acknowledge receipt of the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), dated August 8, 1996, showing a revised Alternate Formulation "D" for this product. The formulation is acceptable and the material has been added to the files for the product.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, your registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e).

Precautionary Statements HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until dry.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed-Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

If in eyes - Rinse eyes with plenty of water and call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish

aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

This water-based insecticide has no strong kerosene odor, and is non-staining.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT OF FLEAS BROWN DOG TICKS, MITES AND LICE:

Treat all cracks and crevices, such as baseboards and around the bottoms of doors. Spot treat where fleas may be present such as under furniture, under edges of floor coverings, dark corners, and favorite resting spots or other places your pet frequents. Provide a good, even treatment, but do not soak the areas you treat. A fine mist or spray applied uniformly is all that is necessary to kill fleas and ticks. Humans and pets should avoid contact with treated areas until spray has dried. Avoid spraying furniture and carpeting. Retreat as necessary.

Fleas are best controlled by a total management program. It is suggested that infested areas be thoroughly vacuumed prior to treatment. The vacuum cleaner bag should be discarded immediately in an outdoor trash container. Continue to discard vacuum cleaner bags until the flea infestation has been brought under control. Use

a registered flea control product on your pets in conjunction with this product.

DO NOT spray pets with this product. Treat your pets with a registered flea and tick product to control the source of your infestation. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pets.

FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, MITES & LICE IN DOG HOUSES AND KENNELS: Remove and destroy pet bedding. Spray interior of dog house, sills and ledges and outside runways.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, CRICKETS, AND CENTIPEDES: Thoroughly spray cracks, crevices, baseboards and around garbage containers and other places where insects habitate.

SILVERFISH AND FIREBRATS: Apply to cracks, baseboards, behind shelving, book cases and other storage areas.

SCORPIONS AND SPIDERS: Spray directly on pests when possible. Treat surfaces of out buildings and garages where pests hide or congregate. Spray points of entry such as window sills and along crevices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
