The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

In the Precautionary statements, you have not submitted data to support deletion of the skin route of exposure. Revise the first sentence of the precautionary statements to match the label stamped 5/2/91 as follows:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin.

In the Precautionary Statements, revise the sentence referring to washing equipment to read as follows:

All utensils, shelving, etc. where food will be handled must be covered or removed before treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

The Storage and Disposal statements are acceptable for products marketed to households. However, for products marketed to the institutional or commercial sites, the label must also include storage and disposal statements appropriate for other listed sites as follows: Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water food or feed by storage and disposal:

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame

Pesticide disposal: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site

or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container disposal: Wrap container and put in trash.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

To kill Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

To kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Centipedes, Crickets. Ants. Scorpions, Spiders, and Fleas: Sowbugs. Spray baseboaards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows and door sills and other locations. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping area. Repeat as necessary.

To kill Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles: Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests, and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in a moth-tight container.

To kill Bedbugs: Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards and floorboards. Repeat frequently.

To kill Rice and Granary Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Chocolate Moths, Drug Store Beetles in exposed adult and larvaestages: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, machinery, and dark secluded areas. Spray 10 to 20 seconds per 1000 square feet of floor space. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear.
