## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks:** Dilute 4 ounces of Concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip solution on animal, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat weekly if necessary for control. Do Not Use on Puppies Under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

## FIRST AID

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and warm water.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
