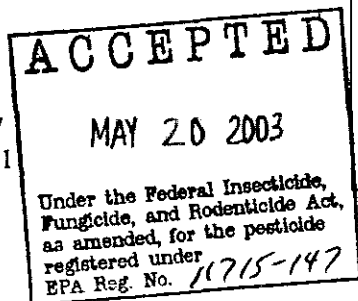

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 4 ounces of Concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip solution on animal, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat weekly if necessary for control. Do Not Use on Puppies Under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.
