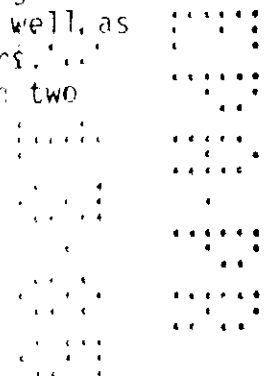
For use in hotels, motels, homes, preschools, nurseries, day camps, greenhouses, lathhouses, seedhouses, food handling establishments, packaging and processing plants, commercial, industrial, office, institutional and storage buildings, milk storage rooms, milk handling areas or milk plants, egg processing plants, supermarkets, restaurants, bottling plants, canneries, flour and feed mills, bakeries, boats, ship cabins and hospitals. IN HOSPITALS: Patients should be removed prior to treatment. Also for use in campers, mobile homes, buses, automobiles, trucks, and boxcars. Also for use in dog kennels and horse stables. IN HORSE STABLES, not for application if horses will be used for food.

Prior to spraying, cover asphalt tile, waxed wood floors, waxed furniture, and fabrics which may come in contact with the fog (newspapers can be used). Close outside doors and windows, and shut off fans and air conditioners.

For best results, open cabinet doors and drawers so that fog may contact all areas where insects can hide and breed. If flea or tick infestation is suspected, destroy pets' bedding and treat pets with a product registered for animal application.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

With can at arm's length, direct spray away from face and depress tab until it clicks into locked position. Moving quickly, direct spray into areas which harbor insects such as under sinks, under and behind stoves and refrigerators, and other similar dark areas. Place can on level raised surface such as a stand or table with protective covering underneath to protect the surface. Exit immediately. Leave area closed for 30 min. to kill house flies, fruit flies, mosquitoes, stable flies (dog flies), gnats (midges), small flying moths (millers), vinegar flies, wasps, hornets, bees, yellow jackets. Leave area closed for 2 hours to kill flying insects listed above and ants, booklice, carpet beetles, centipedes, crickets, earwigs, silverfish (firebrats), fleas (adults and larvae), grasshoppers, ticks (Lone Star and Brown Dog), millipedes, sowbugs (pillbugs), spiders and scorpions. To kill cockroaches as well as all of the listed insects, leave the area closed for 4 hours. Ventilate the treated area for 30 min. Repeat treatment in two weeks or as necessary.
