**Use To Wipe On:**  
First, brush animal. Moisten (but do not wet) cloth and rub over against the hair on legs, shoulders, and most often are seen. Only a light application of excessive amount. After application, bright sheen on the hair.  
**Use As A Spray:**  
Pyrenone Stabilene as a fine mist spray on stabled horses for wet horses' skin.

**Storage:** Store in flame.

**Disposal:** Do not tainer and put in trash.
