## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Pyrenone Stabilene Horse Insecticide has been especially developed for use on horses. It provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

### Use To Wipe On:

First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial where flies most often are seen.

Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin.

After application, brush out thoroughly to bright sheen on the coat. Repeat daily.  
**Use As A Spray:**  
Pyrenone Stabilene Horse insecticide may be used as a fine mist spray to stable area and over stabled horses for fast paralysis and kill of wet horses' skin or exceed two ounce application.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by disposal.

**Storage:** Store in a cool area away from flame.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container and put in trash.
