PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Wash skin with warm water and soap. Do not contaminate food or foodstuffs.

Avoid treatment of nursing puppies or kittens. If treatment is necessary, spray fingertips and rub into animal's coat. Do not spray into eyes, face, or genitals. If reaction should occur, contact your veterinarian immediately.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Keep away from heat and open flame. Do not smoke while spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE ONLY IN WELL VENTILATED AREA

CAUTION: The product may squirt out of the nozzle when the protective nozzle cap is removed—if the temperature is higher than room temperature. Remove protective nozzle cap from sprayer by rotating tab to up position and pressing away from nozzle. Retain protective cap and re-attach between uses. Spray at a distance of 6-12 inches by squeezing trigger repeatedly and rapidly.

DOGS AND CATS

Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm fast stroke spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face and around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finish legs last.

For best results, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES AND KITTENS

Spray back of pet only, then spray on your fingertips and rub into animal's coat and around mouth, nose and eyes.

KENNELS OR PET SLEEPING QUARTERS

Apply thoroughly to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door sills, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where fleas, ticks, and lice may be present. Old pet bedding should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Treat pets with this product before allowing them to enter treated area. Do not spray surfaces where spotting, staining, or discoloration would be objectionable.

HORSES AND PONIES

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, remove excess dirt from legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. To treat face, dampen a cloth with spray and rub on face and head, being careful to avoid eyes. Repeat treatment as necessary.
