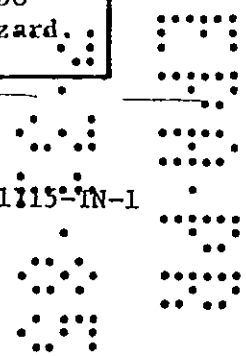

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs and Carpet Beetles:

Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove all bedding. Thoroughly spray cracks, crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where pets normally lie down. Do not spray on pets. Allow the sprayed areas to dry thoroughly. Treat your pet with a registered flea and tick product to control the source of your infestation. Replace bedding before permitting use by animals. For dog kennels, apply to outside runways, window sills and ledges.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
