1. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
2. Make the following changes to your label:
  - a. Delete the word "nursing" from the sentence "Do not use on nursing puppies..." The sentence should read: "Do not use on puppies under 12 weeks of age."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

## FIRST AID

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.  
SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

This product will kill fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 7 days on dogs. Do not use this product on cats.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Do not spray in face, eyes or on genitalia. Repeat weekly, if needed.

Apply at the rate of two seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short haired dogs and up to eight seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
