- e. Add the following statement to the precautionary section of the labeling:

Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, food storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

- f. You indicate this product is ready to use. How does one apply the product? Is there a pump spray attachment that fits on the container head? Products intended for homeowner use should be marketed with some sort of pump spray attachment or reference should be made on the labeling informing the user of certain pump spray trigger heads that can be used with this product.
- g. Delete or revise the phrase "no more varmints" in the product name since it is a false or misleading statement by implying complete insect control.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

## SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**General:** Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT:**

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick product before reentering area.

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FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Earwigs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Carpet Beetles and Dermestids: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. A stream like spray should be used in points between different elements of construction, between appliances and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

OUT OF DOORS:

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting places (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. Keep out of reach of children.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and place in trash collection.
