Dear Mr. Washburn:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Revise front of the label-- replace "Inert Ingredients" with the phrase "Other Ingredients".
- 2. Delete "Repeat treatment when necessary" and "Repeat as needed" statements or indicate the repeat interval which should be based upon the residual effectiveness of the product.
- 3. Under Precautionary Statements delete, "In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water" and "If poisoning occurs get prompt medical aid". This is already addressed under First Aid.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use Speer E-Z 1 Residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches.

waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas, where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Stream should be used in points between different elements of construction between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames, as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
