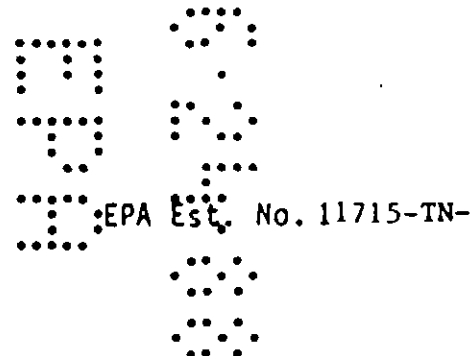

Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs and Carpet Beetles  
Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames behind and beneath sinks, stoves refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor coverings where these pests may be present.
