Your Application Dated August 15, 1995

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. For all products add the statement "Shut off electrical equipment."
2. For EPA Reg. Numbers 11715-137 and 11715-178, make the following changes:
  - a. Delete the term "unobstructed areas" and the sentence "Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of the mist is not assured."
  - b. Add the statements "Place cant at least 6 feet from pilot lights." and "Use only one can per room."
3. For EPA Reg. Number 11718-137, add the statement "Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table."
4. For EPA Reg. Number 11715-178, delete the word "Exclusive" from the statement "Exclusive Water-based Formula" since words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

USE ONLY WHEN AREA TO BE TREATED IS

Harmful if inhaled, swallowed, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Prolonged or frequent repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. ### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extremely flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator. Newspapers should be spread on the floor for several feet around area of release.

**IMPORTANT!** To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARD**, use can as follows: Use only one can per room. Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**If swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Note to physician: May present aspiration hazard. **If inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Call a physician if effects occur. **If on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of restaurants, establishments, restaurants or commercially prepared or processed areas while food is exposed or being prepared. Serving areas are areas where food is prepared or held. In the home, food and utensils should be covered and washed before use. Exposed food should be removed. Non-food areas are restrooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewer), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, mop closets and storage (after cleaning).

### Not for use in USDA

This product will kill fleas (adult and larvae), gnats, ticks, cockroaches, earwigs, moths, clothes moths, mosquitoes, grain beetles, rice weevils, pantry beetles, wasps, hornets, and yellow jackets.

Close doors and windows. Cover the treatment area. Shut off pilot light. Turn out all open flames except pilot light. Fogger in the middle of the room. Place newspaper to prevent marring surfaces. Use one cubic foot of area (approximately 100 cubic feet of area (approximate).

To start fogging, press down on the handle. Keep at arm's length when releasing the handle from face and eyes. Set in up position. Building at once. Leave undisturbed and windows and allow to air out.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in a cool dry place. **Disposal:** Replace can if damaged. Do not incinerate or puncture.
