Dear Ms. Butler:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Move the following statements from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section to the Directions for Use:

"Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Remove all motor vehicles before using in garages."

2. Delete the following statements from the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section. These statements are redundant and/or in conflict with the First Aid statements:

"In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists."

3. Delete the following statements from the bottom of the middle column on page 1. These statements are incomplete and/or redundant and should be deleted in accordance with PR Notice 98-6 (Flammability Labeling Requirements for Total Release Fogger Pesticides):

**"IMPORTANT!** To avoid **FLAMMABILITY HAZARD**, use can as follows: Use only one can per room. Do not place in cabinet or under counter or table."

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DO NOT** use more than one fogger per room. **DO NOT** use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft. by 5 ft. or smaller; instead allow fog to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical**

**appliances that cycle off and on (i.e. refrigerators, thermostats, etc.)** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Non-food areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries, and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

**Not for use in USDA meat and poultry plants.**

This product will kill fleas (adults and larvae), houseflies, gnats, ticks, cockroaches, carpet beetles, ants, spiders, flying moths, clothes moths, mosquitoes, silverfish, sawtoothed grain beetles, rice weevils, pill bugs, crickets, confused flour beetles, wasps, hornets, and palmetto bugs.

Close doors and windows. Open cabinets and doors within the treatment area. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Fogger should be placed on floor in the middle of the room. Place newspapers under the container to prevent marring surfaces. Use one container for each [ ]\* cubic feet of area (approximately [ ]\*).

To start fogging, press down actuator tab to lock in position. Keep at arm's length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 1 hour.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not puncture or incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
