To Kill Fleas, Lice, and Ticks: Dilute 4 ounces of Concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip or sponge animal with solution, or pour over animal making sure hair is thoroughly wet to skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Do not repeat treatment for one week.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse empty container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
