Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in a warm place without rinsing or toweling.

- Delete "long lasting" from "This concentrate gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats." You may indicate how long the control actually lasts based on efficacy data.

e. Change "...cleaning of equipment" to "...disposal of equipment washwaters."

3. Submit 5 copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake Concentrate well before use. This product must be diluted before use. Shake or stir thoroughly before using or reusing the final diluted emulsified solution.

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), in one gallon of water. Dip animal into solution. or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal.

This Concentrate gives long lasting residual control and repellency of fleas and ticks on dogs and cats. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
