**To Kill Fleas, Lice, and Ticks:** Dilute 2 fluid ounces (4 tablespoons), in one gallon of water. Dip solution on animal, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow animal to dry in a warm place without rinsing or toweling.
