**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

To operate, hold the container upright about 3-12 inches from the animal's hair. Using a firm, fast stroke, spray a fine mist on animal's coat until completely and evenly dampened. For better saturation, run your hand against the lay of the hair and spray into the ruffled hair. Make sure spray wets any ticks. Do not repeat treatment for one week. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication.

Spray interior of kennel and pet's bedding thoroughly. Replace soiled bedding and spray fresh bedding. Spray lightly into air wherever animal is present.
