IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention.

- 2. Add the statement "Contains petroleum distillates" as a footnote to the Inert Ingredients declaration.
- 3. Revise the Active Ingredient declaration for Pyrethrins. This product contains 0.05% Pyrethrins, not 0.25% as indicated on the proposed label. Make the appropriate adjustment to the Inert Ingredients declaration.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit three copies of revised final printed labeling prior to releasing product for shipment.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Before applying WIPE P to your horse, brush him down thoroughly to remove loose dust and dirt. Moisten (but do not soak) a folded piece of Turkish toweling (approximately 12" x 15") with WIPE P. Rub briskly against the growth direction of hair. Give special attention to shanks, legs, shoulders, neck and facial area of horse where flies tend to cause the greatest problem. Add more WIPE P to the applicator as needed, applying approximately one to two ounces for the total application on a daily basis (the variance will depend on the size of the horse but should not exceed 1 oz. on ponies or 2 oz. on horses). Avoid using excessive amounts. Do not soak the skin. Groom with a brush.

To kill attached ticks, dab WIPE P directly on the tick with a saturated cloth.

A FEW IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:

*In order to keep the applicator moist and ensure proper coverage of WIPE P it is recommended that the cloth used be kept in an airtight container (a tin can will do) between uses.

*Regular daily applications of WIPE P may build up repellency. Because of this, its effectiveness may be increased enabling a reduction in the amount of WIPE P applied on a daily basis.

*To provide maximum effectiveness, the best time for application is early morning.

*Climatic conditions such as temperature and humidity and cleanliness of the horse's coat will affect the amount of repellent required to do an effective job. Because of this, you may have to experiment with the amount of WIPE P in order to arrive at the optimum amount needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
